### Maxwell Fernie Organ Scholarship

Last Sunday evening in our Church there was a magnificent concert and tribute to the late Maxwell Fernie, Organist and Music Director at St Mary of the Angels from 1958 until his death in 1999. The first Maxwell Fernie Organ Scholarship was awarded to Thomas Gaynor.

Thomas is in his 2<sup>nd</sup> year as an organ student at the New Zealand School of Music, studying with Douglas Mews, having started while he was in his final year at school. While still at school last year Thomas won his class in the Sydney Organ Competition and also the New Zealand Organists' Association Organ Competition. He lives with his parents in Wadestown and is the Richard Prothero Organ scholar at the Anglican Cathedral.

We congratulate Thomas on this award and look forward to his association with St Mary of the Angels. Thomas gave a short recital following the presentation and his talent was clearly evident.

I also wish to sincerely thank the Fernie family and the trustees of the Maxwell Fernie Trust for providing this scholarship. The generosity of so many people has made it possible for Max's legacy to continue in our beautiful Church.
