## Submission to Parliament's Inquiry into Suicide and Euthanasia

This weekend is the last chance to write submissions to Parliament's inquiry into suicide and euthanasia. (The closing date is 1 February but letters should be posted no later than Tuesday 26 January.

Every single submission counts! The two opposing sides – pro-euthanasia and anti-euthanasia – are reported to be running neck-and-neck. Both camps are fully aware of how important this 'vote' is - because if and when David Seymour's euthanasia bill is drawn from the Private Members Ballot, MPs will look carefully at these results. If the majority is in favour of euthanasia now, it will make it very hard to oppose the bill later.

Letters can also be submitted via an online form at suicideinquiry.nz/submit-online/

To make a submission either go to the website above or write a short letter. A 'letter' can be as short as one sentence, such as 'I don't want assisted suicide and euthanasia to be legalised', ideally with a reason or a story.

It is at times like these that we should remember Edmund Burke's famous words: 'All that is necessary for evil to flourish is for good men to do nothing.'
