Bill Prior RIP


Last Friday I celebrated the Requiem Mass for one of our very faithful parishioners Bill Prior. Bill died in Wellington Hospital on 22 July after some months of ill health. He has just celebrated his 88th birthday. The funeral for Bill took place at St Peter and Paul's Church in Johnsonville.

Bill came to New Zealand from the United Kingdom in 1952. He and his wife Cecelia married in St Mary of the Angels Church on 13 February 1960. They lived for many years in Brooklyn and were parishioners at the 7am Mass in our Parish each Sunday. In recent years they moved to Johnsonville but still attended the 7am Mass here at St Mary of the Angels. Bill was a builder by trade and Cecelia volunteered for many years in the Crypt before the Church closed providing refreshments for those less fortunate.

I mention this in our Angelus today acknowledging Bill and Cecelia as faithful and committed parishioners of our Parish for many years. One of the sad things for me as Parish Priest over the past three years is not to have been able to celebrate the important events for our parishioners in

the Church they dearly love. I know that there is nothing we could have done to change that because the strengthening work on the Church needed to be undertaken so that we have a safe building to gather for worship. I am very much looking forward to the day next year when we return to our beautiful Church so that we can once again celebrate the important spiritual events for our families and parishioners.


