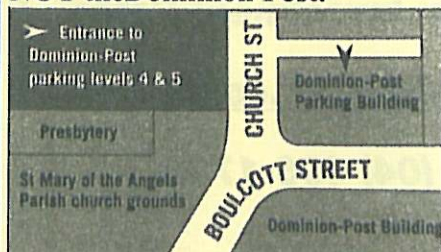

Death of Father Gordon Kerins SM

Gordy ministered nearly all his priestly life to the Maori people in Wanganui, Taranaki, and Hawkes Bay. His Requiem Mass will be celebrated in our Church tomorrow at 10am and then the Maori people will take him to his beloved Waitara for burial.

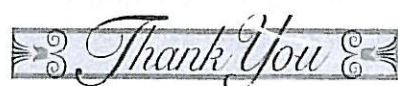
