Pastoral Letter from Archbishop John Dew

A Pastoral Letter from Archbishop John will be read at all Masses this weekend. The Archbishop is writing about 'Project Stronger', - a project which the Archdiocese began last November to understand the earthquake status of all Parish buildings in the Archdiocese. This was necessary for the renewal of insurance coverage which has become very difficult following the events in Christchurch. As an example the insurance premium for St Mary of the Angels has doubled this year to over \$60,000.

The Parish of St Mary of the Angels is very fortunate that the Restoration and Maintenance Committee (chaired by Brian McGuinness) has been working diligently for the past few years on the plans for the seismic strengthening of our beautiful Church. We are perhaps the only Parish in the Archdiocese where this was happening long before the earthquakes in Christchurch. You will appreciate that for the engineers, architects and builders involved, the seismic strengthening of a re-inforced concrete Gothic Church such as St Mary of the Angels is very challenging. Not only is the Church a Category A Historic Place but it is absolutely vital that the character and integrity of the building be preserved.

As I mentioned in the Angelus of 12 December last year, the Maintenance and Restoration Committee have reached the point where their recommendations will be 'peer reviewed' by four leading seismic engineers. This very important meeting takes place on 20 April. It is expected that following the outcome of this meeting recommendations will then be forwarded to Archbishop John for his consideration.

Please keep all those involved in this project in your prayers.


