Hospital chaplains are funded in part by the Interchurch Council for Hospital chaplaincy (ICHC). ICHC's Healthcare chaplaincy is motivated from, and is underpinned by a Christian theology and seeks to provide care for patients in the most appropriate way regardless of denomination, faith, belief or ethnicity. It addresses the spiritual, emotional and pastoral needs of people in hospital.

# **ICPE Worship Night**





# St Mary of the Angels Gardens

I am very aware of the wonderful new growth that comes at this time of the year. Over the past few days I have visited the Botanic Gardens where the spring growth is so evident – if you haven't seem them the 'tulips' are certainly worth a visit in the next few days.

I am also very conscious that with the untimely death in May of our gardener, Sioeli Helu, our gardens around the Church and Presbytery are in need of some tender loving care. Some things are happening:

- the garden at the entrance to the Church received some much needed new soil over winter and with some recommendations from Nicky Oliver-Smith from the Wellington City Council Berhampore Nursery we are planning to replant it in the next couple of weeks.
- a couple of young men from Challenge 2000 are preparing a section of ground around the Presbytery for the planting of some roses.

However, I need a volunteer or volunteers to help maintain the rest of the gardens on a regular basis. It would mean coming along for a couple of hours each week and turning over the soil, removing any weeds so that the gardens remain a pleasure for the many people who use the grounds each week. If you are willing to help please let me know.

Unfortunately we also have to pay for the plants and roses – the City Council no longer supplies free plants. If you would like to help cover the cost of the new plants and roses you are very welcome to make a donation.

I hope that in the next few weeks our gardens will be back to the high standard we were familiar with when the late Sioeli Helu so tenderly and lovingly cared for them.
