



The cost is \$15 for a dozen cards and envelopes.





Third Sunday of Advent

The Third Sunday of Advent is "Gaudete Sunday". The title "Gaudete" Sunday comes from the first word of the Entrance Antiphon for this Sunday's Eucharist:

'Rejoice in the Lord always, again I say rejoice. Indeed the Lord is near!'

We rejoice! Our anticipation grows: the Lord is near. The air quickens and shimmers with palpable expectancy. This palpable expectancy reveals itself in our gospel reading for today.

"A feeling of expectancy had grown among the people, who were beginning to think that John (the Baptist) might be the Christ" (Luke 3:15).

John, of course, made it clear that he was not the Christ. Rather, he was called by God to prepare a way for the Christ.

"Prepare a way for the Lord" has been the general theme of our readings throughout the first two weeks of Advent. Now, with "Gaudete" Sunday, that theme gradually switches our gaze from the Lord's future return to his birth in Bethlehem.

The paradox for us is that we rejoice with anticipation and expectation for the Lord's coming by making preparations to celebrate a birth that happened all those many centuries ago! In this paradoxical way, we concertina time so that past, present and future are drawn together to one fixed point in time – the birth of the Saviour and the dawn of our salvation.

We take up the exuberant praise of the prophet Zephaniah from the first reading for this Sunday:

"Shout for joy, daughter of Zion, Israel, shout aloud! Rejoice, exult with all your heart, daughter of Jerusalem... The Lord your God is in your midst" (Zephaniah 3:14, 17).

Today we begin to feel once more that expectancy of newness that comes from God.

Because past, present and future are concertinaed down to the moment of Christ's birth, we too are gathered with the many down through the centuries, all gathered round his lowly manger to remember and to celebrate his birth; because his birth is the dawn of our rebirth. And, so, we rejoice!
