

There is more to things than meets the eye.....

During the past week the beautiful Maxwell Fernie Organ in St Mary of the Angels Church has been dismantled and put into storage. It was necessary to do this because of the seismic strengthening work which will take place over the next few years. Pipe Organs are very sensitive and they do not take kindly to dust and dirt – two things which are part of any construction site.

The big surprise for me as the organ was dismantled is the sheer volume and number of components which make up this extraordinary instrument. Two large shipping containers were required so that there was enough space to pack each component safely and ensure they are fully protected and in pristine condition for re-assembly when that time comes.

It reminds me that so often when we look up at the beautiful Rose window in St Mary of the Angels Church we only see the large outer pipes of the Organ. But in reality there are hundreds of smaller pipes in behind these large ones. They are always hidden but are so important when it comes to the quality of the sound which fills the Church when the organ is played.

Having just celebrated the Feasts of the Sacred Heart of Jesus and the Immaculate Heart of Mary it reminds us that what we see on the outside of a person is only superficial – what comes from the heart is what really matters.


