This year it will be held in St Joseph's Church, Mt Victoria. The liturgy consists of the Psalms with their Gregorian antiphons, and Palestrina's setting of the Magnificat. It lasts about 50 minutes, and is followed by a short concert of choral music, where the choir will sing music from their traditional repertoire of Peter Philips, Palestrina and Byrd, including settings of Ave Maria by Victoria, Rachmanninov and Stravinsky.
