

# **Fundraising Update**

In the past week a further 19 parishioners have responded to the Seismic Strengthening Appeal. To date fifty-three parishioners have returned donor cards or made donations. A sincere thanks to all of you who have responded with generosity.

There have also been a number of donations in the past week from people who are not parishioners but who are prepared to help us in our efforts with the Church. We are continuing to contact those who attended the Fundraising Launch at Parliament on 7 August to seek their support for the project.

A crucial date is looming. The next round of applications for Lottery Grants closes in December. We need to raise at least \$3 million before then so that we are able to submit our application for a grant. If we miss the December round then it will be well into 2015 before we can apply again. That means a huge delay in getting work underway.

Please consider what you as an individual or a family can do to help raise this first \$3 million so that we can make an application for a Lottery grant before the next round of applications close in December.


