#### Reflection: Our Family Synod

Pope Francis opened the Synod on Marriage and Family Life last weekend with an impassioned plea for his bishops to heed the voices of the Catholic world and not to impose what he called "intolerable moral burdens" on



the faithful. The Synod comprises 200 bishops, including our Archbishop John Dew, and a number of lay people invited for their expertise in topics related to the theme.

There is huge interest around the world in this gathering which continues till next Sunday, October 19. Discussion and debate will centre on moral issues relative to modern family life, including abortion, contraception, homosexuality and divorce. While there is likely to be some vigorous exchanges, we should not expect immediate change in the Church's teachings, although there will be definite indicators to where change might eventually come.

In his opening address, Pope Francis had some cautionary but encouraging words:

"Synod gatherings are not meant to discuss beautiful and clever ideas, or to see who is more intelligent. Rather it's an opportunity to work generously with authentic freedom and humble creativity."

Such an approach should spur us on to support this unique occasion with sincere prayer. Pope Francis is leading the way to meaningful reform. He asks for our prayer. We must not let him down.
