

## Father Peter Bradley S.M. RIP

Last Friday I attended the Requiem Mass in Christchurch for Father Peter Bradley sm who was the Parish Priest of St Mary of the Angels for seven years between 1982 and 1988.

He was an extraordinarily gifted preacher having been part of the Marist Mission band earlier in his priesthood. He was responsible for major work on the Church in the mid 1980s. This involved the cleaning and repair of the stain glass windows, the water/sand blasting and repainting of the outside of the Church and the installation of the copper roof. There are some amazing photographs of this work taken by the late Margaret Philpott.

Father Peter has been in ill health for quite some time. I was able to acknowledge his valuable contribution to St Mary of the Angels during my eulogy at the Mass. I am sure from his place in heaven that Father Peter will help us in our efforts to raise the necessary funds for the seismic strengthening of the Church. May he rest in peace.
