

Parish Accounts for the Financial Year 2014/2015

The Parish accounts for the financial year ending 31 March 2015 are presently with the Auditors. Once we have received the Audit certificate we will present them to the Parish. However, the unaudited accounts show a deficit for the last financial year of \$18,413.24.

This continues a trend in recent years where the Parish income received during the year is insufficient to cover expenditure. This has been made more difficult since the closure of the Church in July 2013. We have lost approximately 170 parishioners on Sundays from our Masses. We have also lost income associated with weddings, funerals, votive candles and more recently car-parking. Our annual income has reduced by approximately \$70,000 per year.

The Finance Committee have made as many savings as possible to combat this loss of revenue. We always seem to 'get by' because of the generosity of our parishioners. However, I think you need to know that it is becoming increasingly more difficult just to meet the day to day running expenses of the Parish.

James Ring, the President of the St Mary of the Angels St Vincent de Paul Conference will speak for a couple of minutes at the end of Mass today. He will tell us about the work that is carried out by St Vincent de Paul in our Parish.
