





## 14th June 2015, 11th Sunday of Ordinary Time - Year B

## Maurice Brown - RIP

It is with great sadness that we have heard of Maurice's passing. He has been a prominent member of the Parish for nearly 60 years, and, of course, a member of the choir for all of that time. Those who attended 11am Mass over the years will remember him as a very eloquent reader, possessor of a marvellous bass voice, a man of real presence and mana.

I became choir director in June1999, and I remembered Maurice from my days as a student when I sometimes sang in the choir. He was very memorable; a big man in every way, in stature and in voice. I soon became dependent on his marvellous knowledge and understanding of the liturgy, his advice, occasionally his censure, but in all things, his support, at a time when I really needed it. Although I was familiar with much of the music and the chant, I had very little knowledge and less understanding of the liturgy. I regularly sought his guidance whenever (which was often) I felt at sea.

For many years he was one of our cantors, sang solos, and gave the bass section its marvellous stability of tone, pitch and musicality. He kept contributing as long as he could, and when he finally had to stop, well into his eighties, he had been singing in the choir for nearly 60 years, what a record, and what a contribution.

Another choir member of many years standing is John Sullivan, who had this comment on the news:

"Maurice will also be remembered for his fund of understated but extremely funny jokes, his occasional pithy comments, and his beautiful reading of the Passion on Good Friday. Maurice and Stella married relatively late, so they both knew what it was like to be single and unattached over Christmas. So during the 1980s they would put on a special Christmas dinner for all the single choir members who were living away from home. It was very much appreciated."

In all the years that he sang in the choir, he once remarked that he had only missed one Easter. His reason was that he had gone to Australia, as he put it, "I had an engagement to sing with Pavarotti", delivered deadpan, followed by his dynamite enormous grin.
