#### Euthanasia

This topic is one of the most important issues we face as Christians and a country as Parliament considers the voluntary euthanasia Bill in the very near future. Cardinal John recently wrote to all Parish Priests and Lay Pastoral Leaders and in that letter he says:

"It is important that we as a Catholic community encourage each other to become informed and knowledgeable on the issue. It is also important that as many individuals as possible be encouraged to make personal submissions to the Health Select Committee as well as their MP's, so as to convince them of the complexities and dangers of euthanasia and assisted suicide".

To help us become better informed I have asked Doctor Leo Buchanan, a respected parishioner and recently retired pediatrician to speak at all Masses this weekend. Leo attended the meeting of the Archdiocesan Task Group which has been formed to help Parishes effectively confront the very real risk of euthanasia and/or assisted suicide becoming legal in our society.

I sincerely thank Leo for his energy and expertise in helping us understand this proposed legislation being introduced into the New Zealand Parliament.
