Making our Funeral Wishes Known

During this month of November we remember the 'Holy Souls' - those who have gone before us marked with the 'sign of faith'. Recently a parishioner sent me the following reflection and I thought it was worth sharing with the Parish. The reflection begins:

"It is a sad fact that many devout Catholics have family who no longer go to Church. This has a significant flow-on result when it comes to funeral arrangements. People do not know what the dead person would have wanted or, worse, there can be heated arguments as to what different family members think appropriate.

For this reason, it is prudent to spell out in writing exactly what you would like - and to have the directions readily accessible.

Things to think about are:

- specify that you want a Requiem Mass otherwise family may opt for a 'funeral service'.
- whether you want the rosary or evening prayer on the eve of the funeral this is an opportunity for family and friends to speak as the Church encourages only one eulogy at the Requiem Mass or funeral service;
- who would you like to deliver the eulogy;
- what music you would like or not like;
- whether in your will you want to make provision for Masses to be said - or whether you want to leave a legacy to St Mary of the Angels.
- if you leave precise instructions, it will make things easier for loved ones at a difficult time. A Requiem Mass may also in some cases be a rare time family go to Mass. Older friends of the deceased who may not have been to Church for some time may pause and reflect what they have missed and what they may want when their time


