



## **Korean Catholic Community of Wellington - Celebrating Its** 21st Anniversary

The Korean Catholic Community of Wellington (KCCW) celebrates its 21st anniversary on 6th December this year.

In the beginning, a few Korean people met in their homes to promote fellowship among Korean Catholics throughout Wellington. Very soon a regular gathering was formed, but we still went to the Mass in different churches on Sundays. We felt keenly the necessity of a parish that we were able to participate in liturgy including the Mass together. As some of Korean people got baptised at St Mary of the Angels (SMOA) at that time, it was only natural for KCCW to make SMOA as our parish in early 1995. Since then we have been actively involved in various liturgical activities and events of SMOA – altar servers, collectors, special ministries of Holy Communion, singing at the Mass and the Carols with Angels.

As a Community we have gathered in the Parish Hall after Mass each Sunday where we have Catholic teaching and Scripture studies, pray and practice singing with organist David Trott. Also we have Scripture sharing groups meeting fortnightly in the homes and run a regular retreat programme.

We are very proud of our history of Korean Catholic church that was started by lay people without any formal missionary priests and strengthened by the century-long persecution that produced thousands of martyrs, 103 of whom were canonised by Pope John Paul II in 1984 and 124 were beautified by Pope Francis in 2014.

Celebrating the 21st anniversary, we remember our martyrs and will try to follow the example of their spirituality.
