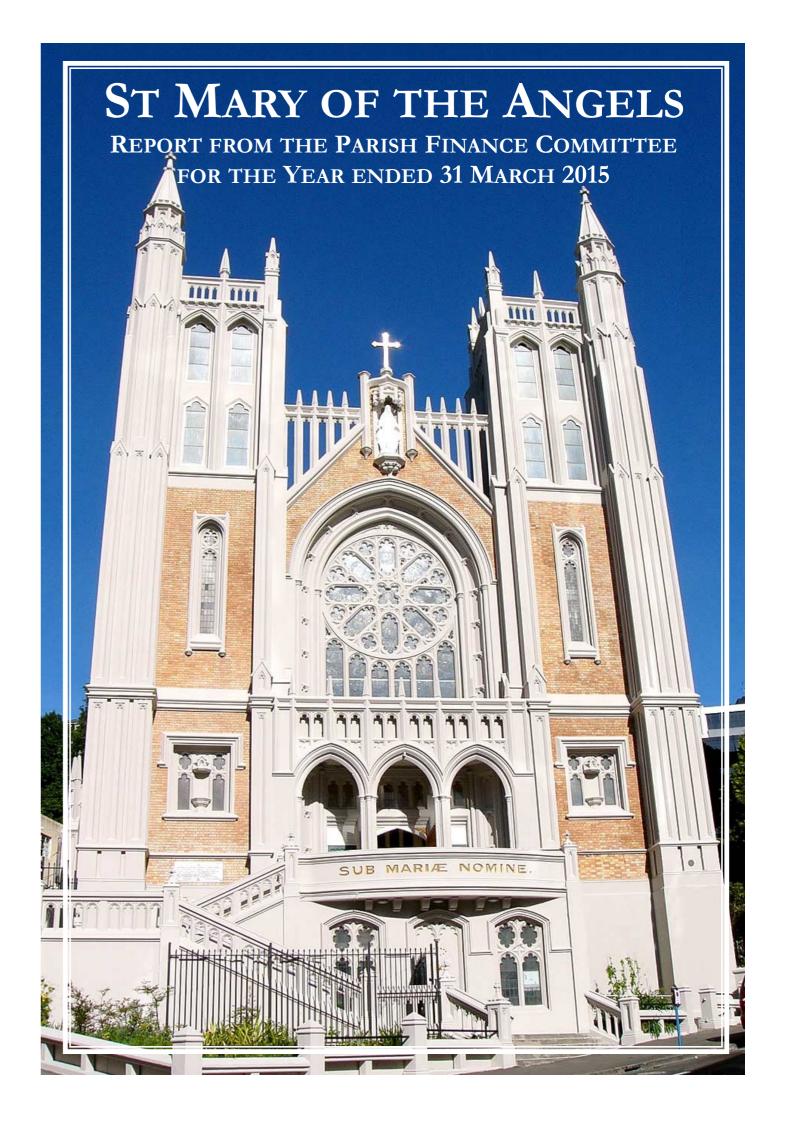

PARISH FINANCIAL REPORT 2014 - 2015

The Finance Committee is pleased to present the financial report for the year ended 31 March 2015. We hope that parishioners will take the opportunity to read this report and to understand the challenges faced by the Parish, especially with the seismic strengthening of the Church.

FINANCIAL PRIORITIES

Unsurprisingly, our two financial priorities remain as:

- Funding the seismic strengthening of the Church and the Parish building (Presbytery)
- Ensuring the Parish's income is sufficient to cover its expenses.

SEISMIC STRENGTHENING

With confirmation of the first one-third of funding, the granting of building and resource consents by the beginning of the year, and the formal approval of our Cardinal Archbishop, the seismic strengthening project began in March following a special liturgy in the Church on St Patrick's Day. That work is now well underway.

Although the Finance Committee is not itself directly tasked with funding the seismic strengthening of the \$9.5 million, members of the Committee have worked closely with Fr Barry throughout the year as he has led the fundraising effort. The first target was to raise at least one-third of the total cost so that applications could be made to the NZ Lotteries Board and that was achieved early in 2015. As at 30 November 2015, funds received or committed were approximately \$6.6 million.

However, we still need a further \$2.9 million to complete the work. The Project Governance Group need to make a decision in early 2016 on whether the project can continue. If work has to stop it may be many years before we are able to worship once again in St Mary of the Angels Church.

COVERING THE PARISH EXPENSES

We continue to be heartened by the financial support of parishioners. However, over the past two years we have had deficits of \$23,489 and \$27,122 respectively.

With the closure of the Church in July 2013 we have lost several sources of income, while at the same time our costs have not been able to be restrained to the same extent. For example, our rates and insurance still need to be paid.
