

Fundraising for Seismic Strengthening of Church

A sincere thank you to those who have generously responded in the past week to the fundraising effort for the Church. As outlined in my presentation last Sunday, we still need \$2.5 million to ensure that work can continue and be completed so that we can be back in the Church by Easter 2017.

This requires an extraordinary level of response from all of us. It is no use thinking that we can leave it to others. As individuals and families we need to respond in whatever way we can to this challenging fundraising effort. As one visitor from Christchurch said during the Mass at St John's last week:

"I encourage all of you here to ensure that what has happened to us in Christchurch doesn't happen to St Mary of the Angels. You have a chance which we never had to save our beautiful Catholic Cathedral. It was proven in Christchurch that buildings that had been earthquake strengthened remained intact. Make sure what happened to us doesn't happen to your beautiful Church."

If you donate before 31 March you will be able to claim on your 2015/2016 tax return.

Please prayerfully reflect on what each of us can do to ensure that the seismic strengthening work continues and that we can return to our Church as soon as possible.
