You are invited to come and join in prayer for the vulnerable children of our nation. Sunday 21 May at 1pm - 2.15pm at St Theresa's Plimmerton.





This year it's our turn to host this celebration, and we will sing the ancient evening liturgy of the Divine Office - the Vespers.

Vespers will be held at 7pm TONIGHT, 15th May, at St John's Presbyterian Church.

As this year's hosts, we will be providing the supper, so we ask our parishioners to maintain our reputation as good providers by bringing something nice to eat.


# Responsorial Psalm 103
