Seismic Strengthening Donations

If you wish to make a donation to the Seismic Strengthening Fund and receive a tax refund in this financial year you will need to make the donation in the coming week i.e. by 31 March. We still require approximately \$800,000 to meet the shortfall between what has been raised and the final cost. Our fundraising continues even though we are planning to reopen the Church for our Easter ceremonies.

There are many things which are not part of the seismic strengthening work but are necessary in order to re-open the Church. These are:

- re-installment of the Maxwell Fernie Organ \$78,000
- new sound system \$40,000
- new carpet in confessionals and sacristy \$15,000

In addition there are major works which will not be possible at this stage. The reinstatement of the Crypt and the Choir Room, the reinstatement of the lawn and gardens, the installation of security lighting around the Church and the renewal of the carpet in the Sanctuary. These items will have to wait until finance is available.

Thank you for your generosity over the past 3 years which has enabled us to preserve our beautiful Church. There is however, much more to achieve before the work is totally completed and unfortunately it all depends on our ability to pay for it.

Planned Giving

Planned Giving envelopes for the next financial year are available at all Masses today. The envelopes are labelled alphabetically by surname and can be found in the entrance foyer of each Church after Mass today, and from the Parish Office during the week. Please collect your envelopes as it will save us the cost of postage.

As we come to the end of the tax year (31 March) it is a good time to review your financial commitment to the Parish. Any lump sum given before 31 March can be claimed in the current tax year. A tax rebate of 33.3% may be claimed on all your contributions. Tax receipts will be issued in April for the 2016/2017 financial year.

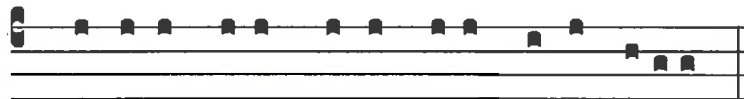
R. The Lord is my shepherd; there is nothing I shall want.

Lenten Reflections from Pope Francis: The Sacraments, Prayer, Fasting & Serving the Poor

As we enter the 4th week of Lent, we should take time to reflect on how we are going with our spiritual preparations for Easter. Can I do more? Who do I serve?

Take part in the sacraments

"Lent is a favourable time for letting Christ serve us so that we in turn may become more like him. This happens whenever we bear the word of God and receive the sacraments, especially the Eucharist. There we become what we receive: the Body of Christ." – Pope Francis, Lenten Message, 2015

Prayer

"In the face of so many wounds that hurt us and could harden our hearts, we are called to dive into the sea of prayer, which is the sea of God's boundless love, to taste his tenderness. Lent is a time of prayer, of more intense prayer, more prolonged, more assiduous, more able to take on the needs of the brethren; intercessory prayer, to intercede before God for the many situations of poverty and suffering." – Pope Francis, Homily, March 5, 2014

Fasting

"We must be careful not to practice a formal fast, or one which in truth 'satisfies' us because it makes us feel good about ourselves. Fasting makes sense if it questions our security, and if it also leads to some benefit for others, if it helps us to cultivate the style of the Good Samaritan, who bends down to his brother in need and takes care of him." – Pope Francis, Homily, March 5, 2014

Almsgiving & Serving the Poor

"Today gratuitousness is often not part of daily life where everything is bought and sold. Everything is calculated and measured. Almsgiving helps us to experience giving freely, which leads to freedom from the obsession of possessing, from the fear of losing what we have, from the sadness of one who does not wish to share his wealth with others." – Pope Francis, Homily, March 5, 2014

"In the poor and outcast we see Christ's face; by loving and helping the poor, we love and serve Christ. Our efforts are also directed to ending violations of human dignity, discrimination and abuse in the world, for these are so often the cause of destitution. When power, luxury and money become idols, they take priority over the need for a fair distribution of wealth. Our consciences thus need to be converted to justice, equality, simplicity and sharing." – Lenten Message, 2014
