Parish Preparation for the Archdiocesan Synod

The Wellington Archdiocesan Synod will be held on the weekend of 15-17 September. Cardinal John has explained that preparation for the Synod should be "a discernment process, listening to the Spirit then to one another as we seek to understand where God is leading us."

Discernment involves reflection, not discussion or debate, and being open to the wisdom of the Holy Spirit, focusing on what we can do to help build our Archdiocese of the future. Most Synod topics are drawn from Pope Francis' priorities - leadership, people at the edges of society and of the Church, ethnic diversity, relations with Māori, refugees and migrants, care for creation, ecumenism, young people, marriage and family.

At St Mary of the Angels we will follow a two-step process for parishioners to reflect on any of the topics and then share responses with your representatives so they can take these to the Synod.

Firstly, during August we invite you to take time for prayer and meditation on the topics either individually or by arranging small groups with others. Included in the Angelus today is a copy of the questions to be considered at the Synod.

Secondly, in September, we invite you at meetings after Mass to share your reflections with those who will represent the Parish at the Synod. You can also share your reflections in writing.

Katyn Memorial Plaque

St Mary of the Angels has enjoyed a very close connection with the Polish community over many years. Many Polish children came to Wellington after World War II and together with their families have become parishioners of this Parish. One of the highlights for the Polish community was the visit in 1973 of Cardinal Karol Wojtyla (later Pope John Paul II) who celebrated Mass in the Church.

Many of us have lit a candle at Our Lady's altar. On the wall at this altar is a plaque commemorating the loss of Polish soldiers at the battle of Katyn during World War II. Following the seismic strengthening of the Church the Polish community would like to re-dedicate and bless this plaque.

On Sunday 13th August his Excellency Zbigniew Gniatkowski, the Polish Ambassador to New Zealand will attend the 5pm Mass and the plaque will be rededicated.


