



Born in Krakow, Zalewski is organist of the Krakow's Wawel Royal Cathedral, which was very close to the heart of the late Pope St John Paul II. It was in this Cathedral that Karol Wojtyla received his episcopal consecration as Bishop on 28 September 1958, and later as Cardinal on 9 July 1967. Cardinal Wojtyla preached at St Mary of the Angels Church during his visit to Wellington in 1973.

Opening the Organ Concert will be a special launch of a limited publication of excerpts of Karol Wojtyla's poem 'Thinking my Country' into Te Reo Maori and English.


