Final Fundraising Effort

We have begun the final phase of work associated with the seismic strengthening of the Church. This work includes:

- re-instatement of the Crypt and Choir room under the Church
- re-instatement of the timber floor in Choir Loft
- concrete repairs inside the twin towers
- outside security lighting
- re-instatement of gardens and lawn
- new carpet for the Sanctuary
- electrical work in Sanctuary
- securing the Reredos to Rear Wall of Sanctuary

This work will cost approximately \$400,000. A fundraising effort to secure this funding has begun and we believe that our generous donors will continue their support so this work can be completed by Easter 2018.
