Seismic Strengthening Update

It is almost a year since we re-opened St Mary of the Angels after the seismic strengthening of the Church. I am sure that all of us during these past twelve months have appreciated the amazing work carried out by our contractor. While the Church was closed they have ensured that the beauty and integrity of this sacred space was preserved. The contract for the work was \$10,140,000 and this has all been paid for thanks to the generosity of so many donors both within the Parish and the wider community.

Over the past several months we have been quietly working on reinstating the Crypt, Choir Room and the grounds. Work has also been carried out in the towers and in the Choir loft. These were separate items from the main contract and we have now reached the point where completion of this stage of work is in sight.

There has been significant work carried out under the Church. A new floor has been laid in the Choir Room and significant drainage created because of water that comes from the two creeks which run under Boulcott Street and O'Reily Avenue. The Crypt upgrade will be a wonderful asset for Parish use.

The grounds are nearly completed with the installation of lighting. Some landscaping is still to be completed. The grounds will be reopened at Easter.

The final work which we hope to achieve in the next few weeks is in the sanctuary of the Church. New carpet will be laid, electrical work will be completed at the rear of the sanctuary and most significantly our beautiful marble Reredos will be more securely attached to the back wall of the Church.

This additional work has so far cost \$244,575. We have managed to pay for most of it through the generosity of our donors. However, we still need an estimated \$156,552 to settle our February accounts and also to pay for the new carpet and work in the sanctuary.

In the Angelus today you will find a donor card and envelope. I hope many of you will assist with this final fundraising effort.


