

# 24 June 2018, The Nativity of St John the Baptist

# A Voice Leading to the Word

It is striking that we observe John the Baptist's birthday in the context of a Sunday Mass. St Augustine's sermon on the topic gives us plenty of food for thought and sheds light on the topic.

... John's mother was old and barren while Christ's mother was young and a virgin. John's father was struck dumb for not believing that he would be born. The Virgin Mary believed and conceived in faith....

John marks the frontier between the Old and the New Testaments. ... He represents the Old Testament and at the same time introduces the New. His parents were old, in keeping with his first role: while yet in his mother's womb he was saluted as a prophet, in recognition of his second. Although he was not yet born at the time of Mary's visitation, he leaped in his mother's womb. His mission was made clear, even before he was born. He was revealed as Christ's precursor, before he so much as saw him....

Zachary fell silent and lost his power of speech until John, the precursor, was born and restored his speech. Is not Zachary's silence a hidden prophesy, kept secret and, as it were, pent up before Christ could be proclaimed? His speech was restored at John's birth, his voice was made clear when he came as he had been foretold. The restoration of Zachary's power of speech is like the rending of the veil of the temple when Christ was crucified. If John proclaimed himself, he could not have restored his father's speech. Zachary's tongue was loosened because a voice was born. When John was announcing our Lord's coming he was asked: Who are you?' He replied: I am the voice of one crying in the wilderness.' John was a voice, but in the beginning the Lord was the Word. John was a voice for a time: but Christ, who in the beginning was the Word, is the Word in eternity. [Augustine, Sermon 293, 1-3]

We are responding, each in our unique way, to an inner desire to become more like Christ, more like the Word of God. It follows, therefore, that how we use our voice is very important. Am I using my voice to announce the presence of the Word of God? Do I use my voice to bring new life to others?


