

Solidarity Leading to Compassion

The apostles were told (Mk 6:30-34), "You must come away to some lonely place all by yourselves and rest for a while." The point is not going away to a lonely place all by themselves but who they are with – Jesus. He is human like them but he is also God. Jesus is showing them how to be compassionate by being aware of what binds all people – their common humanity. A Marist missionary to Bougainville in about 1930, Fr Emmet McHardy, sm, found this way of putting it helpful, "I am made of the same stuff as the worst sinner on earth."

Compassion, when one person feels and suffers with another in their suffering. When we try to be compassionate from an understanding of myself as superior we run into problems. If we view ourselves as superior to the needy person a huge effort is required. Fr McHardy's insight helped him to minister to the people of Bougainville. Having this view of self means that compassion does not take so much effort, all parties are respected, their dignity recognized.

Jesus is not only teaching his apostles that he is in solidarity with all of humanity but he is also teaching them that because he is at the same time divine, they will never be alone. The chief shepherd will help them be compassionate shepherds to others.
