Jesus, The Word of Life

In a commentary of the life and work of mystic, theologian and philosopher, Meister Eckhart, I found this quote: "God cannot be found or grasped in the external world, but only in the internal world. If we seek him outside, we shall find him nowhere; if we seek him within, we shall find him everywhere. This is not to say that only the inner world is real. Both are real; both have their own measure of importance. But it is in the inner world which has the priority and the greater importance ... Having discovered God within, we can discover him without; but never the other way around." [The Way of Paradox: Spiritual Life as Taught by Meister Eckhart, New York, Paulist Press, 1987, P.51]

The religious authorities in the time of Jesus could only understand one side of his identity, a man born from Joseph and Mary. The words, "I have come down from heaven" (John 6:42), caused confusion and anger to them.

However, people down through the ages have been attracted to Jesus. How come? It is connected to the fact that they already have the seed of love in their hearts. Since God's Love is the source of creation, Jesus Christ, the incarnate Word of the Father shows humanity God's love. It is a question of like seeking like. People recognize the love blazing out of Jesus and they move towards it.

It is important to keep seeking. In order to grow, the seed of love in our inner world, in our deepest being, needs to be fed. The bread of life is the Word of God, who will satisfy our hunger.


Taste and see the goodness of the Lord
