

20 January 2019, 2nd Sunday in Ordinary Time

Peace and joy to you and your loved ones as we begin 2019. As I reflect on my first year as parish priest I am very grateful for all the graces of the previous 12 months. On behalf of the Marist Community and Sister Frances thank you for your love and support including the generosity shown to us over Christmas. Thank you also to all who helped in any way with the beautiful liturgies at Christmas time. Your generous sharing of your gifts is appreciated greatly.

We have returned to Ordinary Time until the season of Lent begins on 6 March. In these days when the liturgical colour is green we live with the memory of Christmas. It is a time to deepen our belief that God is truly in our midst, in our daily lives and in a special way during our celebration of the Sacraments. It is a time to expect fresh growth in our lives by our cooperation with the indwelling Spirit.

During Ordinary Time a significant event on the calendar is Waitangi Day on Wednesday 6 February. The Parish of Sacred Heart Cathedral and St Mary of the Angels will celebrate Mass at 9am with Cardinal John Dew presiding. St Mary of the Angels and the Maori community of Te Ngakau Tapu will lead the music. Please bring a plate so that we can host our visitors in the parish hall afterwards.

Last Sunday's Gospel reading told of when Jesus was baptised marking the beginning his three years of public ministry. Today's Gospel reading is his first miracle, the first sign of God's plan to restore creation. The power shown by God in the context of the wedding at Cana when water was changed into wine was the first of many signs that would follow – signs of God's power, God's loving mercy, God's loving compassion. I invite each of us to be attentive during 2019 to the signs of God's ongoing presence.
