

## If You Have Arrived a Little Early

I'm guessing you are reading this before Mass starts. You've got here with a couple of minutes to spare. Well done. It makes good sense to be at any sort of gathering a few minutes beforehand, to get into the right frame of mind, to greet whoever should be greeted (in this case the Lord) and cast our eye over the agenda.

Our "agenda" today is this Gospel. In every Catholic Mass today, in every language and place around the world the same. Here it is ....

A reading from the Holy Gospel according to John.

Jesus said: "The sheep that belong to me listen to my voice;

I know them and they follow me.

I give them eternal life;

They will never be lost and no one will ever steal them from me.

The Father who gave them to me is greater than anyone,

And no one can steal from the Father. The Father and I are one."

The Gospel of the Lord. (John 10:27-30)

That's it. The rest of this 'front page' is padding. You've read what's of value.

If you have more time, then think over that Gospel. What word or phrase strikes you? What do you like? What puzzles you? Let it speak to you personally. The truth is, the Sunday Gospel is our communal word from God for today and this week. God speaks. As he feeds us in Holy Communion.

With a pre-reading before Mass, we're already primed for when the priest reads it aloud. Even the homily will be more interesting – to see what ideas the priest chooses to draw out.

Ok, that's enough from me. Read it again. Jesus said, "The sheep that belong to me.....

Last week we heard the good news that our architects, Bulleyment Fortune Architects and Ian Bowman, Architectural Conservator, Architect in association won gold at the New Zealand Architectural Awards for their work on our church. The citation includes the following: In many ways, St Mary of the Angels is the pinnacle of achievement for Wellington religious architecture, and an expression of faith in the pinning of buildings to the side of rocky outcrops. The restoration and strengthening of the church has been a labour of love for many. Through subtle, understated and almost invisible measures, including this century's only new Gothic flying buttresses, the late Denis Fortune has brought Frederick de Jersey Clere's brilliant design into the modern seismic code era.


