



Book Launch: 'The Perfection of Sound' The Perfection of Sound - the story behind the Maxwell Fernie Organ at St Mary of the Angels is the subject of a new, about to be released book and everybody is invited to the launch. Using the collected correspondence from a parish priest, an organ builder, English pipe-makers and Maxwell Fernie, the book describes in detail how a revolutionary new organ in Wellington was brought to life from a flat in Pimlico, London. The launch will be held in the St Mary of the Angels Crypt on **Sunday 10 November** at 2.30pm, with selected readings, a demonstration of the organ, a glass of wine and an opportunity to purchase the book.
