



Where is God in all of this? A question that frequently arises in my mind. I pray for various things and crises in my life, yet all that I receive is silence! Over past weeks there has been plenty to think about, such as unemployment. You all know what is happening in your lives, and the causes we need to pray for.

Today's Gospel speaks about the sower and the seed. God's Word may be influenced and coloured by my experiences in life, my circumstances, background, and environment. Depending how they influenced me, I can become open to welcoming God's Word and letting the Word bear fruit in me, through me, or I can be resistant to God's Word, making it difficult for God's Word to bear fruit in my life.

What do I need to do to welcome God's Word and allow the Word to grow in my life? I can give new positive angles to negative experiences and circumstances so that they can become converted from being barriers to become opportunities to receive God's Word. I have the power to change my environment, no matter how harsh, cultivating it so that God's Word may grow and blossom in it - to change my experiences and circumstances to become welcoming to God's Word. I need to colour them with a new significance. I am responsible in creating an experience and environment worthy for the Word of God to be sown. I am responsible for allowing God's Word to grow and bear fruit in my life. I am responsible in making my experiences, backgrounds and environment conducive to God's Word. I open the door and I let God's Word in instead of denying him entry.

Let us pray that the Holy Spirit will enlighten our minds and hearts to listen and receive the Word of God so that we may share the Word with others.


The seed that falls on good ground will yield a fruitful harvest.



Alert Level I Parish Guidelines

- Holy Communion The faithful are to receive Holy Communion in the hand only, and not from the chalice.
- **Sign of Peace** The exchange of peace can be by spoken word, by a gesture such as bowing, or by a pause for silent prayer for peace. At this stage people should not feel obliged to shake hands.
- Holy Water Fonts are to remain without Holy Water.

These guidelines will be re-evaluated as further health advice is given. The dispensation from Sunday Mass remains in place. People should stay home if they are sick, and contact their doctor if they have flu-like symptoms.
