Covid-19 Update

Normal timetable returns for weekdays and Saturdays, no Masses on Sundays until Alert Level 1

Upon the consideration and direction from Cardinal John Dew, we will be holding all weekday and Saturday Masses at their normal times and under certain restrictions:

- There is to be no more than 100 people gathered in the church at one time
- Everyone must keep a social/physical distance of at least two metres in each direction
- Everyone must sign in when they enter the church—either with the Covid Tracer App or on our paper register
- Hand sanitiser will be available
- Communion is to be the Body of Christ only and it is only to be received on the hand
- There is to be no sign of peace and no holy water

The **Sacrament of Reconciliation** will be provided at their usual times with social distancing observed, as well as taking Communion to the Sick. Baptisms however, will be delayed until we are at Alert Level One.

Requiem Masses and funerals can take place under Alert Level Two, with up to 100 people present and all other Ministry of Health conditions met.

Should we move to Alert Level One, Sunday Masses will be reintroduced. But during Alert Level Two, Sunday Masses will not be celebrated in the Archdiocese, as in many parishes it is very difficult to ensure that only 100 people are present and to keep the necessary safety precautions in place.
