28 February 2021, 2nd Sunday in Lent

A big welcome to all our newcomers, especially all our new university students. Our parish is excited to have you join us. You are God's beloved and we are your family.

The new university semester is beginning — an exciting new chapter in the lives of young adults. The students are now on their own new journeys with many having moved away from their families. In these first few weeks of their new beginnings, they will also be embarking with us on the journey of Lent.

Lent is a time to strengthen our spiritual lives and draw closer to God. Let us pray that the Transfiguration of Jesus in today's Gospel touches our hearts, strengthens our spiritual lives and draws us closer to God.

Take the opportunity, like many of the students have done, to 'move away from the home we know' or 'get off the mountain' and start again down a new journey—reflecting and sacrificing on the worldly possessions and vices in our life which are separating us from drawing nearer to God.

Even after Lent finishes we should carry on focusing on limiting or giving up the things in our lives that separate us from our Father and take us off the path to our eternal happiness—for what is the point of giving up something that tears us away from our God, choosing the narrow gate, to only then take it back up, turn around, and go down the wider path once again?

St. Augustine said during one of his many sermons, that our goals during Lent should be extended for our whole lives.

"Christians must always live this way, without any wish to come down from their Cross—otherwise they will sink beneath the world's mire. But if we have to do so all our lives, we must make even a greater effort during the days of Lent. It is not a simple matter of living through forty days. Lent is the epitome of our whole life."

In today's first reading, we hear the angel of the Lord tell Abraham, "Do not harm him, for now I know you fear God. You have not refused me your son, your only son."

Abraham's faith was strong and he loved the Lord so much that he was willing to give up his only son—what are we willing to give up for him?


