### I Am With You Always

"I am with you always" (Mt 28:20): this is the promise the Lord made to his disciples before he ascended into heaven. They are the words that he repeats to you today, dear grandfathers and grandmothers, dear elderly friends. "I am with you always" are also the words that I, as Bishop of Rome and an elderly person like yourselves, would like to address to you on this first World Day of Grandparents and the Elderly. The whole Church is close to you — to us — and cares about you, loves you and does not want to leave you alone!"

On the 25 of July we will be celebrating the first World Day of Grandparents and the Elderly, and every year on the fourth Sunday in July close to the feasts of St's Joachim and Anne. This day comes after a difficult year where all around the world we have suffered from periods of isolation and lockdowns feeling a great stress from the pandemic with our elderly as the most vulnerable. The Lord is aware of all that we have been through during this time and has remained close to us when we have felt isolated and alone. Even in these times the Lord continues to send us angels to console us and to remind us "I am with you always".

Having no children of his own, Saint Joachim, grandfather of Jesus often felt estranged from those around him. So, the Lord sent an angel to console him. While he mused outside the city gates, a messenger from the Lord appeared to him and said "Joachim, Joachim! The Lord has heard your insistent prayer".

This day will be a time where I reflect on the important role elderly and especially my Grandparents have had in my life with the trials and tough times they have faced in these recent years. My Gran and Grandad, Peg and Michael Cummins, Parishioners of St Mary Immaculate in Tauranga have always been leading figures on my journey of faith. Although in my teenage years getting up at the crack of dawn to attend the 7am Mass with them was often a struggle, I always left Mass feeling a sense of love and strong connection to them provided by the Holy Spirit. After losing both my Grandad and Pop within a few months of each other I have realized the importance of maintaining the

relationships with my grandmothers and the elderly. As I look out for them when they lose their companions and friends closest to them, I dread the day that my grandmothers pass on.

May every grandfather, grandmother, every older person, especially those who are most alone, receive a visit from an angel. For many this angel will come in the face of grandchildren, the face of family members, lifelong friends or those we have come to know during these trying times when we have learnt the importance of hugs and visits for each of us.


