18 July 2021, 16th Sunday in Ordinary Time

Is it kind? Is it important? Does it help?

These important questions are posed by 92 year old holocaust surviver Edith Egar in her best selling memoir "The Choice".

Edith was just 16 years old when she was taken to Auschwitz with her family. She lost her mother and father to the gas chambers the very day they arrived and she survived with the help and companionship of her sister. Decades later those experiences inform her book along with those of her mentor, another holocaust surviver, Viktor Frankl who wrote in "Man's Search for Meaning" - "Its not the events that determine who you are. It's how you chose to respond to them."

Edith also writes "You can't change what happened, you can't change what you did or was done to you. But you can choose how to live now". She counsels: "Instead of blaming others, take responsibility for your own actions and speech. Before you say or do something, ask, Is it kind? Is it important? Does it help?".

If we were to implement this advice in our dealings with others, it may become contagious and as stated in the forward to Edith's book -

"We are all "heroes in training". Our training is life, the daily circumstances that invite us to practise the habits of heroism: to commit daily deeds of kindness, to radiate compassion, starting with self compassion; to sustain love, to bring out the best in others and ourselves; to sustain love, even in the most challenging relationships; to celebrate and exercise the power of our mental freedom."

These words reflect those of Blessed Frederic Ozanam, founder of the Society of St Vincent de Paul who encouraged early members of the Society -

"Yours must be a work of love, of kindness. You must give of your time, your talents, yourselves. The poor person is a unique person of God's fashioning with inalienable right to respect. You must not be content with tiding the poor over the poverty crisis. You must study their condition and injustices which brought about such poverty, with the aim of long term improvement."

This is a challenge for us all, and we can start by asking ourselves before we speak or act:

Is it Kind? Is It important? Does it Help?


