### A Red Letter Day for the Catholic Church in Wellington Central

Today, Sunday August the 1st, the Catholic community in the centre of Wellington changes forever. Today is the day on which the former parish of St Joseph's in Mt. Victoria officially ceases to be part of the parish of Wellington South and becomes part of the Wellington Central parish of St Mary of the Angels. It is a wonderful occasion for both communities, one that is full of hope and promise as we all look forward to building together a church community that will witness, in season and out, to life in the Spirit here in the heart of the city.

Numerous parishioners from both communities have been working steadily and enthusiastically behind the scenes to make August the 1st a day to remember. I know it will be so because I have seen, in the period of preparation leading up to the celebration, what will be gained by our forming one new parish.

There will be, no doubt, a period of adjustment, of getting to know one another, of assessing strengths and weaknesses - there may even be the occasional bobble along the way! — but there are also clear signs that our shared faith in Christ and our practical commitment to the Church allow us to face our future with great confidence. For example, positive conversations have already started between leaders in both communities exploring how we can combine our time, talents and treasure for the good not only of the parish but also for others beyond our communities.

The celebration of this day will take place at St. Joseph's Church at 9.00am with a Mass led by Archbishop John Dew. Several priests will concelebrate. A liturgy with simple yet evocative symbols has been prepared jointly. And, afterwards, there will be refreshments giving all those present a chance to mix and mingle, to introduce themselves and so begin the process of becoming one parish.

On the surface nothing much will change straight away. The same Mass schedules in both churches will continue as they are now – four Masses, at the same times, every Sunday at St Mary of the Angels and one Mass at 9.00am at St Joseph's. Each week day there will be three Masses, with adoration and confessions, at St Mary of the Angels and one Mass every Tuesday at 8.30am at St. Joseph's. Baptisms, weddings and funerals will be celebrated in each church. However, I hope and pray that, slowly but surely, in ways obvious and not so obvious, we will come together and form one family, where the life of God is nourished and shared in peace and joy - as Mary and Joseph did so long ago.

Truly, a red-letter day for the Catholic Church in the centre of Wellington!
