Blessed Sunday to you all. My name is Deacon Hayden Powick. I have just concluded training with the Marists and have returned to New Zealand to be ordained a Priest. As I have been appointed to the St. Mary of the Angels' Parish, Fr. Kevin has asked me to introduce myself in the Bulletin this week.

I hail from a small village called Wakefield, a little south of Nelson. I am the eldest of seven children. After high school, I completed a Bachelors in Information Technology and soon after did several months of volunteer work in the Solomon Islands. It was here that I first encountered the Society of Mary and, upon my return to New Zealand, I joined the Marist Seminary in Auckland.


After completing two and a half years of philosophy, I went to the Philippines for my religious novitiate with other Marist seminarians from around the world. I then went to Rome to study theology for four years. At the end of this time, I was ordained a Deacon and made my Perpetual Profession with the Society of Mary. I returned to New Zealand just over a month ago for a holiday — which morphed into a lockdown — and have since moved into the Marist Community on the Terrace here in windy Wellington.

It is a blessing to be back home and I am grateful for the welcome I have received. In this Sunday's Gospel from Mark, Jesus reminds us that, 'If anyone wants to be first, he must make himself last of all and servant of all.' In this light, I also look forward to serving the people of God here at St. Mary of the Angels and St. Josephs.

I would also ask for your prayers as I prepare for my Ordination to the Priesthood. Covid permitting, the Ordination is set for the 9th October at 11:00am.


