Welcome Back!

It is so good to be able to write those two small words – "Welcome back!" It seems such a long time since we have been able to congregate, to assemble in St Mary of the Angels as a community and worship God together.

We are not quite there yet, of course. Masses, adoration and confessions have started again only on weekdays – from Monday to Saturday inclusive. But there is the strong hope that we will be able to gather together again on Sundays starting from October the 17th.

But all these prayerful ways we have of thanking God for his great gifts to us, celebrating his mercy and love towards us, will take place with restrictions. It is important that we comply with Government guidelines, as best we can, in our gatherings so that we minimize the risk of contracting or spreading the virus. The easy way the virus spread to the Waikato in recent days is a warning to us all.

And so, we are asked to register before coming to church so that we don't have more than 100 people at mass on any one occasion. We will enter only through the main doors so that we know how many are inside. We can only sit in certain areas of the church. We are asked to wear masks when we join in masses and celebrate other sacraments here at St Mary of the Angels – not just outside the church but inside as well. Perhaps most importantly of all we are asked to receive communion only in the hand; there will be no exceptions allowed. As well, the other guidelines we are already familiar with will continue to be in place: no holy water to bless ourselves; disinfecting our hands upon entry into the church; no physical touching at the Kiss of Peace.

Such restrictions impact on everyone, some more than others. And we may chafe at such restrictions, wonder at the wisdom of them. But we can turn this unusual and unwelcome way of being together to our spiritual advantage and growth! How? I suggest by reflecting on the deeper meaning of the communion we receive.

When we receive communion we do not receive it for ourselves alone. Receiving communion is not a private act of devotion. It is a gift given to be shared. We are called through our communion to go out to others. And there, in church, we can already begin to go out to others by being aware of and acting for the common good — what is best for everyone in this strange Covid world we find ourselves in. The restrictive guidelines, with which we must comply, help us to serve the common good.

Welcome back! Welcome back to our communion with one another. Welcome back to a strange, new world in which we can, once again, rediscover very practically what it means to be one in Christ, in communion with one another!


