### A Question for You

There is a moment in the public life of Jesus when he confronts his closest disciples with a question, a question that challenged them as it still challenges us today:

"Now Jesus and his disciples set out for the villages of Caesarea Philippi. Along the way He asked his disciples, Who do people say that I am?" They said in reply, John the Baptist, others Elijah, and still others one of the prophets.' And then he asked them, But who do you say that I am?"

The question is so clear, even blunt, that it must have stopped Peter and his companions in their tracks. Jesus was asking them to declare themselves, to stand up and be counted. There was no avoiding the question. It had to be answered.

In our time Pope Francis has also challenged us with a question which is just as clear, even just as blunt as the one Jesus put to his disciples nearly two thousand years ago:

"What do you say the Church should be? What do you want the Church to be in the future?"

This is the question that is at the very heart of the Synod that Pope Francis has called – an Assembly of Bishops and other representatives of the Church - to meet in Rome in 2023. It is not the first such Synod. There have been numerous Synods since the Second Vatican Council finished in 1965. But this is the first Synod in which every member of the Church has been invited or challenged to contribute, to have their say.

It would be so easy to be jaundiced against this initiative of Pope Francis, even perhaps a little cynical. To think of it as nothing but a public relations exercise. But when has jaundice or cynicism ever achieved anything? We can either stand to one side and let the opportunity pass us by or participate and journey with the Church as it tries to be even more faithful to the Gospel.

It is a question that demands that we stand up and be counted. And we can begin to do precisely this by taking part in an afternoon of prayerful discernment at St. Joseph's, Mt Victoria on the 20th of November.

Never before in the history of the Church has a Pope issued such an invitation. Why would you turn it down?

- Communion on the hand only


