21 November 2021, Solemnity of Christ the King

Christ the King

"I came into this world for this: to bear witness to the truth."

Christ the servant leader gave up his life in the ultimate sacrifice when he faced death and was crucified for the redemption of humanity.

In today's Gospel when Pilate asks Jesus "Are you the King of the Jews", Jesus says, "Yes I am a king. I was born for this, I came into the world for this: to bear witness to the truth; and all who are on the side of truth listen to my voice."

This raises the question for me as to whether I am prepared to seek the truth or accept complicity rather than speak out for justice and the common good of all. The truth appears to be found in all that is inherently "good", in following the path of truth we are actively contemplating our relationship with Christ our King and this means changing our misguided behaviours. How can we turn what is bad into good. Christ through his earthly life showed us a very different way to view leadership and to model our lives on his way.

The image of sovereignty that Jesus presents to us is one of servant leadership.

A leader who is happiest seeking company with the unloved, and sharing food and the basic needs of life with those people who have been treated as "outcasts in our society".

A leader who speaks out for those who have experienced injustices, who visits and comforts the sick.

A leader who can be found at the prisons helping support prisoners re-integrate into society.

A leader who questions power structures that are corrupt.

There are many ways that Jesus has challenged us to reflect on what true leadership means.

The "Truth" Jesus speaks of, conjures visions of us being guided by the Spirit to understand the meaning of Jesus's words and the message of his life to us in 21st century Aotearoa. If we allow the Holy Spirit to be within us, we will open ourselves to truly walk in the footsteps of Christ the King.

When we reflect on the Kingdom of God we are drawn to an awareness of a God of eternal love, a place of everlasting peace, and the Spirit of truth represented by all that is good.

As we gather together as the Body of Christ may we be a witness to Christ the King-our Servant Leader.

- Communion on the hand only




