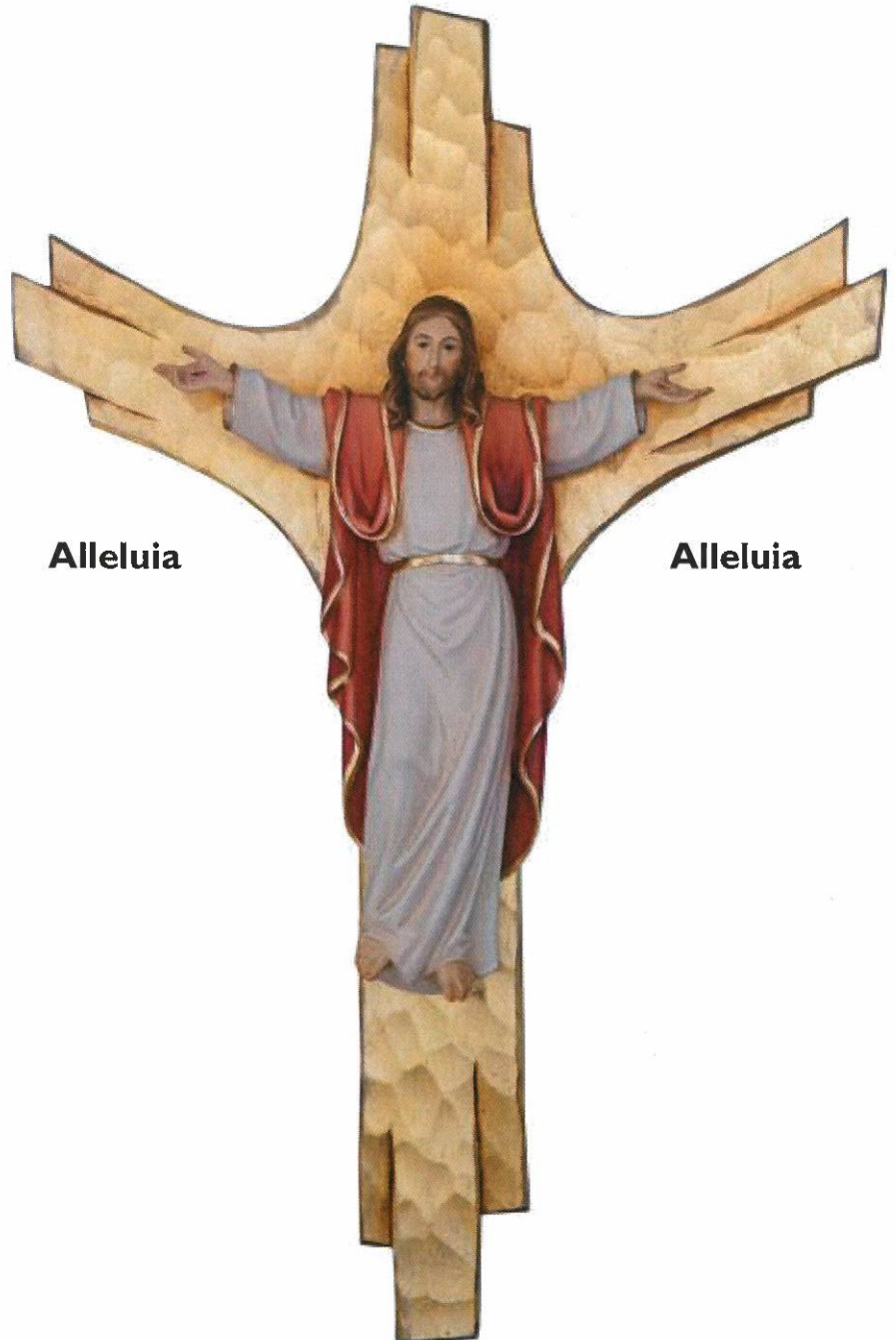

Urban Café

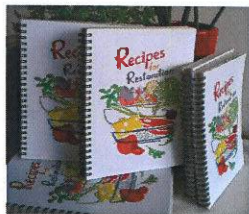

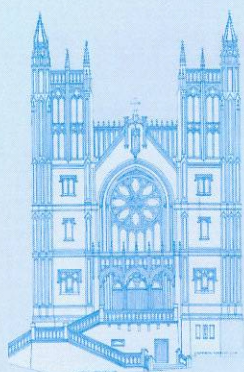
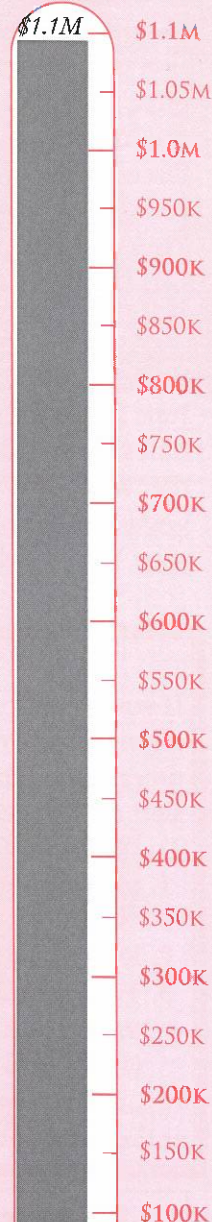
ANZAC Day Concert
