50 Days of Easter

If you thought the 40 days of Lent was a long time, the church actually celebrates Easter for a longer period. Easter is celebrated for 50 days until Pentecost. Imagine a spiritual feast that lasts for 50 days. We are inspired as we enter into the life and experience of the early Christian community.

We begin the Easter journey with the special remembrance of God's Mercy (Divine Mercy Sunday) and we hear the first gift Jesus wants to be in the hearts of his followers is peace: "Peace be with you" (John 20:19). Sometimes we feel that Lent did not go as deeply as we had hoped. But Lent was really a spiritual preparation for Easter. Let's enter Easter as deeply as we can. As we begin the new 50 day journey we may like to consider how we can live some of the Easter themes of peace in our hearts (and not fear), courage to listen and follow Jesus (and not simply follow the world), give daily public witness of Jesus' love (and not reduce Jesus to 'church').

This Sunday we begin celebrating a monthly 'youth – young adult mass' at the 4th Sunday 5pm Mass. Each month we wish to provide a special place of welcome and faith celebration for our young people. Bring your families and have courage to invite youth and young adults to join their lives with God. To help our young people (and all of us) journey closer with God we share some reflection resources that can support your faith journey. Enjoy this special Easter Journey of the next 50 days. Let it be a new season of prayer and a radical adventure living a holy life boldly like the early Christian community.
