Strengthening and Renovation of Parish Hall and Offices' Project

The project is virtually finished! All that remains to be completed is the positioning of the wind lobby outside the main entrance to the parish hall. A glass and metal construction this should be completed and fixed in place about the middle of May.

The end result is impressive. The facilities are now so fresh and attractive — light, airy, comfortable and spacious. As well, the 'traffic flows' both upstairs in the offices and downstairs in the hall have been made more logical and easier to negotiate. A great boon is the large storeroom which we never had before and which allows us to keep the hall attractive and welcoming rather than being cluttered and off-putting. The kitchen has also been updated and incorporated the advice of caterers we consulted in order to make it more user-friendly. The most obvious change — and a very positive one! — is the way the hall looks out onto the gardens on both sides through the floor to ceiling glass windows and so creates a sense of calm and openness.

I am thrilled with what has been achieved not only through the hard work of the architect, Nick Bevin, and the contractors, L.T. McGuinness, but also through the generous sacrifices of all at St Mary of the Angels who contributed financially.

The project did begin to slow down from January this year for three main reasons: the delays in supply chains began to impact us; covid interrupted the availability of labour; and tradesmen were often in such great demand that they were unable to be on site on the dates originally planned.

Financially it looks as if we will be either slightly over or slightly under budget. The final accounting will not be clear, I suspect, until sometime late in May or early in June when the wind lobby has been completed and installed. I will keep you informed once our definitive financial position has been determined.

A formal opening and blessing will take place towards the end of this month. The precise date will be announced nearer the time once we have had made the necessary arrangements.

Finally, I would just like to repeat my thanks to you all. The community of St Mary of the Angels has come together once more and shown its commitment to this church and its facilities which for one hundred years this year has been at the very centre of the city and its life. I am very proud to have worked with you all on this project.






