# 12 March 2023, 3rd Sunday of Lent

#### Ko Hata Maria, Te Matua Wahine O te Atua

Holy Mary, Mother of God

Late last year we needed to order a reprint of the 'Angelus' newsletter template. We decided to place the image of Hata Maria on the front page to acknowledge the dedication of St Mary of the Angels as the national shrine, as well as adding the name of St. Joseph's which had been incorporated into the parish in August, 2021. The finished design is now fresh, even bold, yet also soothingly attractive.

It proved easier to find a position for the image of Hata Maria in the weekly parish newsletter than it did to find a permanent position for the image in the church! Over many months different positions in the church were suggested and then discarded as being intrusive, unattractive or simply impractical: on one of the two side altars; replacing the statue of the Holy Family in the side niche; in one of the disused confessionals; in the Baptistry; in the Crypt underneath the church. No suggestion won overwhelming favour! Now, I am happy to say, the Bishops of New Zealand have agreed where to place Hata Maria.

The image will be positioned at the back of the church where the present statue of the Sacred Heart rests. Hata Maria will be elevated so as to cover most of the windows that form the background to the Sacred Heart. The three panels that constitute the image will stand flat against the windows. Further decoration around and above the image, incorporating those parts of the windows still uncovered, will be added to enhance the setting and further draw the attention of parishioners and pilgrims alike to the significance and meaning of the image. The table on which the statue of the Sacred Heart now rests will be completely removed.

It is thought that the statue of the Sacred Heart would be best placed on a plinth in the foyer of the church so it is Christ who rightly welcomes his people at the doors and into the liturgical assembly gathered together by his Spirit.

When Hata Maria will be moved from her temporary place in the Baptistry is not yet clear. The sketches indicating her place are now being turned into definitive plans; then it will be the turn of skilled workmen to execute the wishes of the architect. I would hope all will be finished in time for the feast of Pentecost this year.

Finding her rightful place in the church is only beginning, of course! Next, we must ready ourselves to be a welcoming community to the pilgrims whom we hope and pray will grow in number as the months and years roll by. To this end the parish pastoral council has approved the formation of a committee to take responsibility for promoting the national shrine throughout New Zealand and even beyond. This committee will soon begin its work.

May Hata Maria inspire and guide us all as we continue to walk with Jesus Christ, her son.
