

11 June 2023, The Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ

Today we celebrate the beautiful Feast of Corpus Christi, Body of Christ. Some of us will remember the processions that used to be held in the cities and various parts of the country. Many of our churches were decorated with large numbers of candles and flowers and many stayed on for adoration during the day which concluded with solemn Benediction.

The most treasured gift the church holds is the mystery of Christ's presence in the Eucharist. Jesus is here with us, He has made us part of Himself. Jesus our God has not left us, He is here to nourish and sustain us, to renew and strengthen us. He wants to be close to us. He wants to be as important to us as the food and drink we need each day to nourish the body. Jesus broke bread with the disciples the night before He died and handed it to them, He was leaving us an eternal covenant that will never pass away. We need the Eucharist for nourishment of the soul. Don't deprive yourself of receiving the Eucharist whether it is from a Priest or extra-ordinary Minister. Remember it is the Lord Himself that you are receiving. It is the same Christ.

"No sacrament contributes more to our salvation than this; for it purges away our sins, increases our virtues, and nourishes our minds with an abundance of all the spiritual gifts. It is offered in the Church for the living and the dead, so that it may be beneficial to all, as it was instituted for the salvation of all." (St Thomas Aquinas).

At each Mass we pray with Christ and in the power of the Holy Spirit to the one great God who is Father of us all. This unity extends beyond space and time. Mary, the Mother of the Body of Christ is present with us as are all the Saints and all who have gone before us. We pray for our needs, Holy Father, Bishops, Clergy and all People, they also are part of our community, which is a symbol of the whole Body of Christ we call the Church.

Here at St Mary of the Angels we are very blessed as we have Masses each day with Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament. The number of people who come in for a visit is very edifying. Christ Himself is present in the Sacrament of the Altar. He is to be honoured with worship and adoration.

"If you really love Jesus in the Eucharist, you will naturally want to put that love into action. We cannot separate these: the Eucharist and the Poor. Let us adore Jesus in the silence of the Eucharist. If we want to love Jesus come back to adoration" (St. Teresa of Calcutta).

Let us pray today for a blessing; for our Priests, extra-ordinary Ministers of the Eucharist, Readers as they renew their commitment on this wonderful feast.
