New Zealand was dedicated to Mary as 'Our Lady Assumed into Heaven' by Bishop Jean-Baptiste Pompallier when he celebrated the first mass in Aotearoa New Zealand at Totara Point in the Hokianga on the 13th of January 1838.

On the Feast of the Assumption, 15 August 2021, all the country's bishops gathered in Wellington for a Mass to renew Bishop Pompallier's 1838 dedication of Aotearoa New Zealand to Our Lady Assumed into Heaven. During the nationwide



Covid-19 lockdown in 2020, many Catholic parishioners urged the bishops to dedicate Aotearoa New Zealand to Mary to seek her protection. The bishops believed the idea of a renewal of that dedication could help revitalize people in their faith during a period of pandemic crisis.

The bishops commissioned an artwork, "Ko Hāta Maria, te Matua Wahine o te Atua - Holy Mary, Mother of God", to commemorate Mary in a way that is unique to Aotearoa New Zealand. The artwork went on a hikoi, "Te Ara a Mary - Mary's Way", visiting all dioceses of Aotearoa New Zealand from August 2021 to August 2022.

The NZCBC dedicated St Mary of the Angels as a National Shrine to Mary in August 2022.

As a Māori depiction of Mary, the artwork is of special significance to tangata whenua and a taonga for all Catholic faithful in Aotearoa New Zealand.

Following the consultation with the Bishops, Hata Maria will be placed at the end of the nave/main entrance between the two doors, where she will offer visitors the sense of holy mission as they depart. The statue of the Sacred Heart will be removed. The installation of the artwork will be done in the next few weeks, and we anticipate disruptions and apologise if this may cause any inconvenience. We thank the Bishops Conference for their generosity, support and guidance with the installation.

We hope that this installation will be completed in time for us to celebrate the Feast Day of Assumption of Mary. We will keep you informed.

As a parish, we are responsible for the care and maintenance of the artwork and the promotion of St Mary of the Angels as the National Shrine. The Parish Council have formed a committee tasked to promote St Mary of the Angels as the National Shrine and to care for Hata Maria.

There will be projects and events planned throughout the year by the Committee. We have been meeting regularly. With pleasure, I would like to introduce the members of this committee Darlene Adrian, Ernest Adu, Heidi Kristono, Graeme Ellis, Fr Kevin Mowbray, Damien Dempsey, director of NZ Catholic Bishops Conference and Rebecca Taylor-Hunt, representing Catholic Enquiry Centre.
