### Of Earthquakes, Insurance and other Financial Challenges

We live in difficult times! Especially when it comes to balancing budgets – for home, for school or for our businesses. It is the same for our parish. And so, earlier this year the Parish Pastoral Council decided to form a Revenue Subcommittee to research whether the parish can continue to pay the insurance costs for natural disaster. This year, for example, our total insurance premiums payable amount to \$142,000. That is an extraordinary amount to be paying on an annual basis – and it is almost certain to keep on increasing!

The Revenue Subcommittee has focused on identifying how the parish can increase existing funding and how it might develop new sources of funds. Such funds would need to be substantial and on-going if we are to pay natural disaster insurance every year.

The subcommittee has focused initially on increasing revenue rather than decreasing expenses because the biggest annual expenses are largely fixed. Reducing other expenses would not yield significant savings, nowhere near enough to cover natural disaster premiums!

As well as looking directly at parish revenue, and how that might be improved, the subcommittee has to keep in mind that not all revenue donated to the parish remains in the parish. Each year we are asked to show our solidarity with the archdiocese by financially contributing to its programs that might otherwise lack sufficient funding.

So far, the subcommittee has considered a substantial range of options from small-scale fundraising ideas to large events. In particular, it has looked at better utilizing our facilities at St Mary of the Angels and St Joseph's (e.g. naming the new parish hall and marketing this as a venue for corporate meetings, functions; advertising more widely the church as available for concerts which respect the nature of the church) and employing new technologies to make payments and offerings easier (e.g. QR codes and "tap'n pay" options). The subcommittee is aware that such technologies need to be carefully researched as there are questions around the issuing of tax receipts as well as security and privacy issues.

The subcommittee is expected to submit its report to the Parish Pastoral Council by the end of October this year.


