10 December 2023, 2nd Sunday of Advent—Year B

A shimmering vista hazed in heat, the inviting coolness of river water, the shiver of expectancy, the commanding voice of the preacher: "Someone is following me, someone more powerful than I am. I baptise with water. He will baptise with the Holy Spirit". A veritable heightening of expectation! Such is the mood of Advent. There's going to be a happening; a happening of something long foretold. So long ago that its promise has become a distant memory and, for some, more fable than reality. Who can blame the creeping unbelief from generations of storytelling of divine promises of surprise and foreboding? Such is the wariness of Advent. Dare we renew our hope and fan our longing into flame? Such is the challenge of Advent. Will the Son of Man find faith when he comes?

Are we simply baptised in water for the forgiveness of sins? No! That is the baptism of the Baptist! We are baptised in water and the Holy Spirit. It is the Spirit who forgives: the Spirit of God, the Spirit of Christ. We believe that the preacher's "someone" has indeed arrived. He has walked among us; he, who "has existed since the beginning, that we have heard, and that we have seen...that we have watched and touched with our hands: The Word, who is life". Now, we wait. We wait for his return. Will creeping unbelief seep into our veins from generations of telling, from generations of waiting? Do we hold his promise of return more a fable than with conviction? Will the Son of Man find faith when he returns?

The world has turned his first appearing into a market place of tinsel and Santas. If we are to resist the hype of worldly Christmases and smell again the scent of an earthy birth, can we resist creeping doubt in his return? Can we revive the voice of hope, surprise, foreboding and expectancy behind the herald's cry "Prepare a way for the Lord! Make a straight highway for our God" as we wait his return? Such is the riddle of Advent; a riddle we are called to answer; an answer dependent first on our response to his question: "But, you, who do you say I am?"



The Jesse Tree

During Advent we reflect on how God was revealed to people in Old Testament times before the coming of Jesus. Matthew's Gospel (1:1-17) links the Old and New Testaments. He sets out the genealogy or whakapapa of Jesus' earthly family through which history, knowledge, philosophies and spiritualities were handed down until the birth of Jesus.

The Jesse tree is a visual reminder of this. The name comes from Isaiah's prophecy (Isaiah 11:1) that the Messiah or Saviour would come from among Jesse's descendants.

The symbols on the tree are based on centuries of Christian tradition. The symbols vary between Churches and the St Mary of the Angels Church symbols are explained further in the Parish App under 'Links'.
