THE NUMBER, SEVENTY-TWO'

Why seventy-two disciples? Is that the number that Jesus actually sent out on mission, as Luke records in the Gospel reading of today? Was it a number that is only meant to indicate a lot were sent? Was that the number that volunteered when Jesus asked who was willing to preach the Good News? None of those questions helps us to understand the real reason for the number seventy-two. As always, when we see a number quoted in the Scriptures we can expect there to be a hidden meaning.

For the Jews of Jesus' time the number of disciples sent on mission represented the sum total of the pagan nations, believed to be seventy-two. So, what was being announced by this number is that the Good News was not meant just for the Jews, the Chosen People of God. The Good News is for every nation on earth. It is Good News for the whole world! The seventy-two disciples are a symbol of how the Word about Jesus Christ should never have limits put on it. It is meant to be shared with all people of all ages in all places. There is a dynamism built into the Word we receive each Sunday through Scripture and the Eucharist which should compel us to go out and go out again. Always to go out! A pope was once reported as saying to a missionary bishop, who asked him how he should develop his diocese, 'Go further on!'

Today's Gospel says a lot more than just urging us to 'go out, go further'. It offers some really sound advice about how we should preach the Good News in our day and age to our Kiwi contemporaries who normally don't like being lectured, especially about religion. Don't expect too much; be realistic - we are like 'lambs amongst wolves'. Trust in yourself, who you are - 'carry no purse, no haversack, no sandals'. Don't get into an argument with someone - 'Let your first words be, Peace to this house.' Judge whether people are ready to listen; if the time is not favourable then don't become a rude and maddening bore - 'we wipe off the very dust of your town'.

In a word, if we want to be effective missionaries at home, at school and university, in the workplace, always treat others as you would want them to treat you. Then, like the seventy-two you will 'come back rejoicing',


